

Quarantine Restrictions for Employees Traveling Out of State & Returning to New York

New York State is requiring people to quarantine for 14 days after traveling to a state with significant degrees of community wide spread of COVID-19.

Please note that if you travel outside of New York and are mandated upon return to quarantine for 14 days you will be required to use additional vacation time and/or go on approved unpaid leave if you cannot work from home. Additionally, none of 14-day quarantine period for personal travel is eligible for NG COVID-19 Emergency Sick Leave.

We ask that employees let their supervisor/manager and Employee Services (888-483-2123) know in advance if they are traveling to a state with restrictions and will be required to quarantine afterwards.
